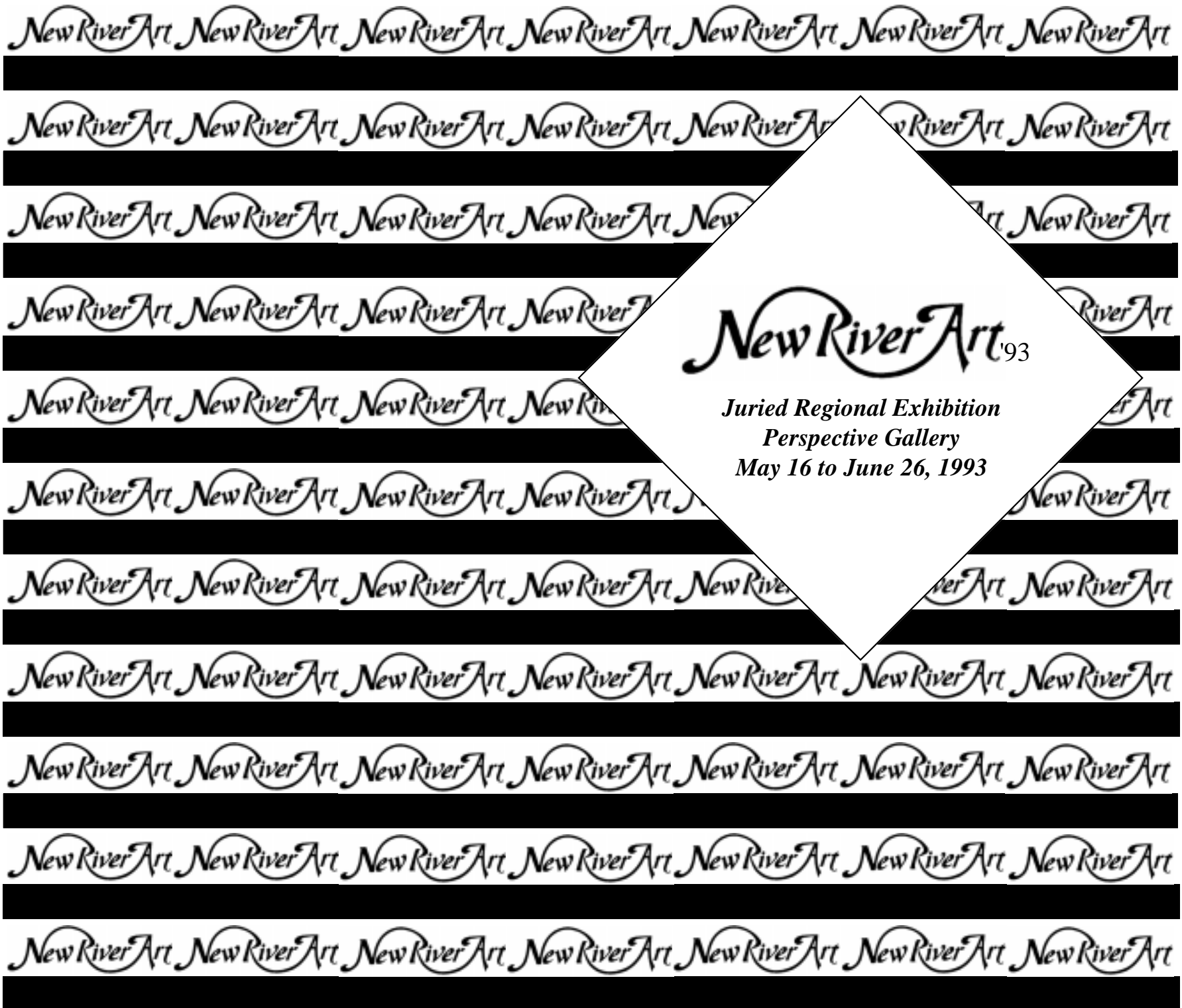

Juror's Statement: Julyen Norman

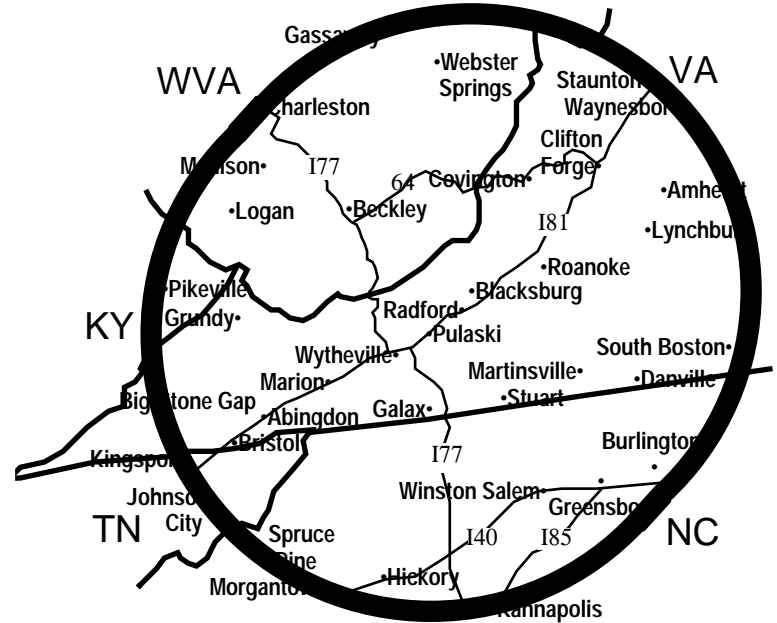
Contemporary

"I'm much more interested in ideas than appearances, much more excited by the 'what if' principle than the 'this is the way it really is' rule. I also enjoy having a very eclectic temperament, there are very few things in art, or music, or literature, that I absolutely don't like at all.

Professional artists face incredible obstacles in making art today in this country. An indifferent, often hostile, public, unschooled in contemporary aesthetic issues, naturally undervalues the artists' contributions, commitments, and sacrifices. As Executive Director of 1708 Gallery, an 'alternative space' in Richmond, I feel privileged to be able to champion ideas over dogma, experiment over repetition, risk over statis.

"...a favorite form of relaxation for me is reading murder mystery novels, I can't get enough of them. I tend to view a drawing the same way the fictional sleuth approaches the scene of the crime- I look for evidence of a struggle. The greater the struggle, the better I like the drawing."
