

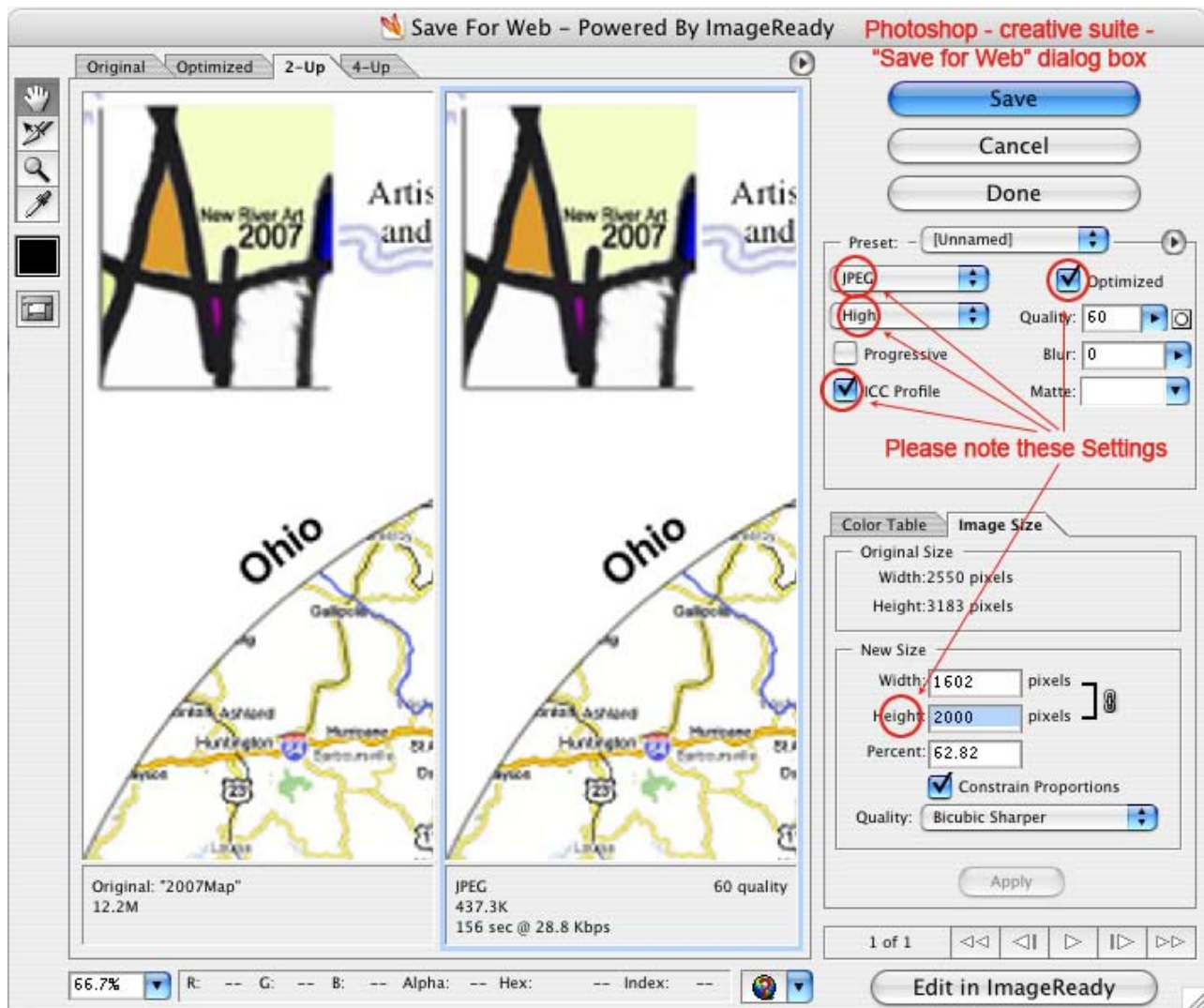
New River Art '07 Digital entries:

The basic requirements for Digital Entries on CD are:

- File type: jpg (high) File size: Maximum of 1 mb and 2000 pixels (on the longest side)
- File names: First 7 characters of artist's last name, first initial, and entry number separated by dashes (example: doe-j-1.jpg)
- CD name: Burn CD with your last name, first initial as the label truncated as above.

Here are some additional tips:

- After you have a scan that looks very close to the original, print it for a double check.
- Resist the temptation to make the digital file better than the artwork - too great a difference will result in rejection on delivery.
- When you save your file you can choose to embed ICC and web-optimized settings within the file as shown below. These will help prevent color shifts and keeps the file size low.



All submitted works will be converted to digital format for initial jurying so any monitor/platform issues will affect all entries equally. (Jurying for awards will be made from the actual works after the show is hung.) I will be directly supervising scanning. If you wish to submit "real" prints on paper. I will "eyeball" entries to be sure there are not changes in color or contrast. Perhaps I should mention I've been scanning art for over two decades.

If these comments make no sense to you, it might be wise to use a slide or printed entry instead. We will do the digitizing work for you. Of course we'd prefer that you help us if you can!
